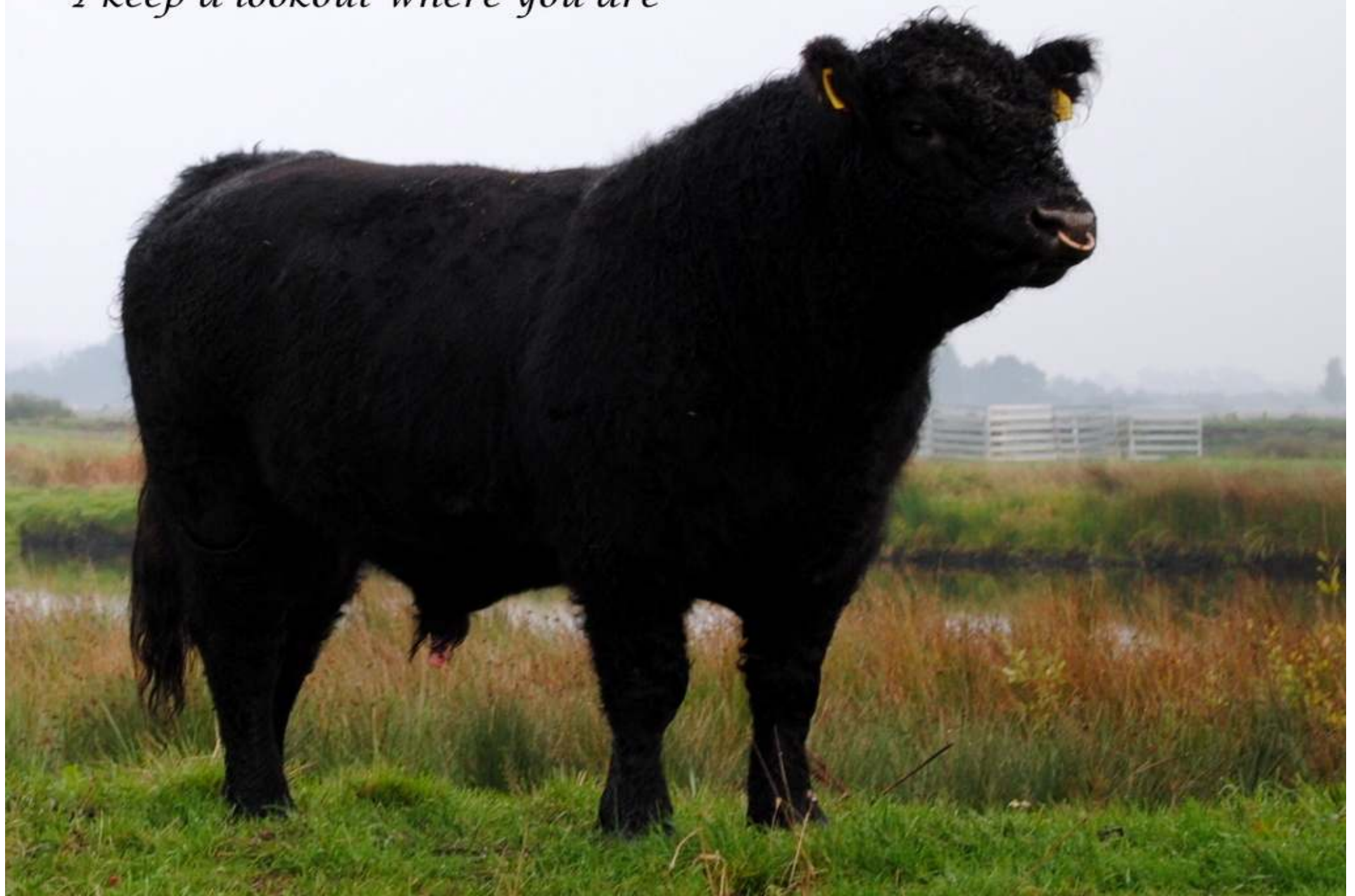

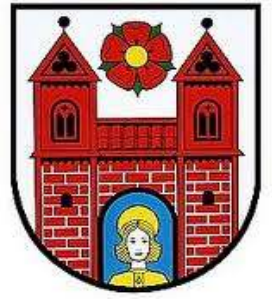

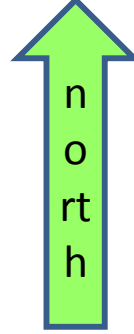


Wildeshausen is a historical place
